Important Information for Parents of Campers

Thank you for enrolling your child (ren) in our camp. We are planning a wonderful and adventurous experience. To make this camp run as smooth as possible, we ask that the following procedures be followed. Listed below are the themes for this year's camp season. We emphasize these themes during the specified weeks in various aspects of the program. **On Fridays, we have a special dress-up time, in accordance to the theme from 8:45-9:00 a.m. time. This is a fun time in which the campers vote on who is the best dressed. All the participants receive a prize and the winner receives a grand prize.**

1. LABEL, LABEL, AND LABEL: Label all clothes, towels, bathing suits, backpacks, lunch boxes sun screen etc. The children are responsible for putting their belongings (all of them) back into their backpacks at the end of the day. However, anything left behind will end up in "Lost and Found". WPBC will only keep the lost articles for 2 weeks. They will then be donated to local charities. Please check Lost and Found to ensure you get your lost items back.

2. BACKPACKS /LUNCH BOXES: Please do not have your child keep money or any other personal items in their backpacks/or lunch boxes. Items can get lost or stolen, if you are sending money with your child have them give it to the front desk worker so they may secure it for them. Cell phones/IPods any electronic game is not permitted at camp. WE will not be responsible for any of these items.

3. CAMP HOURS: Campers may be signed in any time after **8:00 a.m.** and should be picked up by **5:30 p.m.** Early sign in is between 7:00 and 7:59 a.m. late sign out is between 5:31-6:00 p.m. All Children must be picked up by **6:00 P.M.** Early sign in /late stay charge of \$2.00 per fifteen minutes, per camper, will be assessed. Special pricing is available for weekly early care and late stay. See church office for details.

4. ATTENDANCE: It is recommended that child (ren) be escorted in (**not dropped off**). All children must be signed in and out. Attendance is taken at the front desk as the children arrive as well as in their respective groups.

5. ABSENCE: Parents should notify WPBC when your child (ren) will be absent. You only pay for the weeks that you come and it helps us to allow people on the waiting list to know if there is an opening.

6. FOOD AND DRINKS: Cold packed lunches are to be provided by the parent. Please send some nutritional snacks as the children will have both a morning and afternoon snack time. Campers will be allowed to buy drinks/ snacks from our canteen at a price ranging from .50 to .75 cents. **Friday Hot Lunch for \$3.00 is available weeks 1 through 9. Microwave foods are not permitted.**

7. MEDICATION: Any medications sent to the camp must be in the original container and must be accompanied by a note indicating the proper dosages and times and a signed permission to administer to the camper.

8. PAYMENT: A child may come for a friend day fee of \$30.00. **Two or more days you must pay the full rate plus registration fee, unless it has already been paid.** Payment is due at the beginning of the week. **(No exception).** We are a non-profit ministry and pay the counselors at the end of the week. **We cannot allow your children to attend camp if there is an outstanding balance. We accept Cash, Check -Visa, Master card and American Express.**

9. SIGN IN/OUT AND PICK UP PROCEDURES: It is our policy for parents/guardians to both sign in and sign out their children. We need to have written permission for your child(ren) to ride or walk off grounds as well as the time you expect them to leave the camp grounds.
