What our Summer Day Camp Program offers:

Learn a Sport time

Various sports will be taught by our staff to enable each camper to have an introduction to basic sports rules and skills. Other games will also be a part of the program.

Daily Chapel time

Our daily chapel program teaches Biblical principles of morality, respect for God, parents and country. While we expect every child to participate in chapel, there will be no pressure placed on them to join our church or to be baptized. The bible is taught from a literal standpoint. The King James translation of the bible is used for uniformity (campers are not required to purchase bibles, but will have an opportunity to earn one if they wish). Pastor Michael L. McClure is responsible for the organization of the chapel program.

Lunch time

Each child should bring his or her own lunch with a cold pack as necessary. The camp does not have facilities to heat or prepare food. A Kool-Aid type drink will be provided at no additional charge. Children should bring healthful snacks for their break times. We suggest lunches and snacks that do NOT require refrigeration. While there is always water available, children may also purchase drinks and snacks from the canteen if they desire.

Nap Time

Nap time will be available on an as-needed basis for those in the 5-7 year age group. Children need to bring their own nap mat in the event of nap time.

Variety of Classes

Each year we offer theme weeks with a variety of classes, including crafts, etiquette and life-skills training, self-defense training, competition time and fun games. We schedule guest speakers and special events coordinated to the theme of the week.

Swimming

The West Park Baptist Church is one of the few summer day camps to have an on-site swimming pool. All campers will have a daily swim time, under the supervision of our life guards and counselors.

Registration Fee

There is a one-time non refundable registration fee of \$50 per camper.

Weekly Camp Fee

1 camper - \$125.00 per week
2 campers - \$85.00 (Total \$210.00 per week)
3 campers - \$40.00 (Total \$250.00 per week)
4 or more - \$30.00 additional per week

A camper may bring a friend for one day for \$35.00. Any camper attending more than one day must register and pay for the full week.

Payments

Payments are due on Monday of the week your child is attending. We accept -Cash—Check and all Major credit cards .
Fee for any return check : \$20.00

Hours of Operation

Early care 7:am-7:59 am \$2.00 fee for every 15 minutes

Our hours are 8:00 am - 5:30 pm daily; however early and late care are available. Please let us know in advance if you will be needing this service. A charge of \$2.00 per 15 minutes will be incurred for time prior to 8 am or after 5:30 pm. Children must be picked up by 6:00 pm.

Late Pick up 5:31 pm-6:01pm \$2.00 fee for every 15 minutes

Guidelines for Parents and Children

Camp Fees

We endeavor to offer the best possible program for the lowest price possible. We understand the great demand upon today's family incomes and we will continue to offer our camp program without seeking financial profit. We view our camp as a ministry and service to the community.

What to Wear:

Sneakers/sports shoes, slacks, jeans, long shorts (which come to mid-thigh).

For swimming, girls must wear a modest one piece swimsuit. Modesty is the emphasis, so tummy and bottom must be covered. With all the games and sports played we do not recommend sandals or open-toed shoes.

What Not to Wear:

GIRLS: No short shorts, halter tops, spaghetti straps, see through shirts, mini skirts, bare midriff tops, French-cut, extremely low cut or bare midriff swimsuits.

BOYS: Must wear a shirt except when in pool area, no short shorts.

EVERYONE: No shirts or clothing that reflect or advertise anti-Christian products, philosophies, or characters.

What to Bring:

Towels, proper attire* see above, lunch, am & pm snacks and a GOOD attitude.

What Not to Bring:

Video games, radios, any personal music or media playing devices, inappropriate literature, cell phones, weapons, etc. The church staff reserves final determination in the above cases.
